C. General Hints to Format Your Extended Abstract

Note that the official language of the workshop is English.

1) *Positioning*: Figures and Tables: Place figures and tables at the top and bottom of columns. Avoid placing them in the middle of columns. Large figures and tables may span across both columns. Figure captions should be below the figures; table heads should appear above the tables. Insert figures and tables after they are cited in the text. Use the abbreviation “Fig. 1”, even at the beginning of a sentence.

D. Preparation of Extended Abstracts for Printing

All accepted contributions (abstracts and slides or poster) will be made available on our webpage. The abstract will also be distributed in printed proceedings to the workshop’s participants. Therefore, please use this template which is the IEEE manuscript style for conference proceedings (templates as provided in IEEE Proceedings manuscript style, <http://www.ieee.org/web/publications/pubservices/confpub/AuthorTools/conferenceTemplates.html>) for your abstract (at most 2 A4 page). The slides or poster will be distributed in electronic form to the participants.
